OASIS-D is coming! Implementation on January 1, 2019 will usher in many changes including:

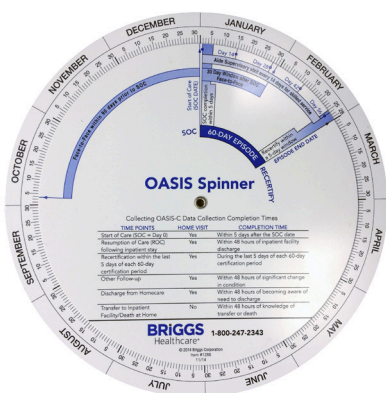
- New standardized patient assessment data elements

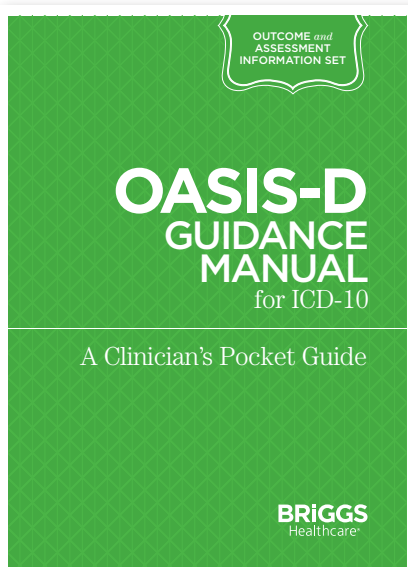


Home Care OASIS Spinner

OASIS-D Guidance Manual

Effective January 1, 2019, this version of the manual introduces new and modified items. Some are standardized patient assessment data elements (SPADEs), added to meet the requirements of the Improving Medicare Post-Acute Care Transformation Act of 2014 (IMPACT Act). Standardized guidance for the new items is included.

The manual also includes revisions to correct, update or clarify guidance. See Appendix G for a summary of changes from OASIS-C2 to OASIS-D.

Comprehensive Adult Nursing Assessment Including SOC/ROC OASIS Elements with Plan of Care Information (3491P-19)

UPDATED for OASIS-D and compliant with the CoPs - this 32-page booklet is used to document a comprehensive adult nursing assessment with both the Start of Care (SOC)/Resumption of Care (ROC) OASIS item sets, and Plan of Care information. This form is used for patients who require OASIS data collection at SOC and when a patient resumes care after an inpatient stay.

Recertification/Follow-Up Assessment Including OASIS Elements with Plan of Care Information (3492P-19)

UPDATED for OASIS-D and compliant with the CoPs - this 24-page booklet is used to document updates to the comprehensive assessment. This assessment integrates the OASIS item sets for recertification and other follow-up (significant change in condition).

Discharge Assessment Including OASIS Elements for Discharge Not to an Inpatient Facility (3493P-19)

UPDATED for OASIS-D and compliant with the CoPs - this 22-page booklet is used to document updates to the comprehensive assessment. This assessment integrates the OASIS item sets for discharge when patient is returning to the community (not an inpatient facility); as well as the acceptable reasons for transfer or discharge of the patient from the HHA as noted in § 484.50(d).

Care Summary Including OASIS Elements for Transfer to Inpatient Facility/Death at Home (3494P-19)

UPDATED for OASIS-D and compliant with the CoPs - this comprehensive 8-page booklet is used to document summary information for a transfer to inpatient setting OR a death at home. This care summary includes the OASIS item sets for these time points requiring OASIS data collection.
