

Selecting The Correct Dodge 5.9L Common Rail Injector



This bulletin covers how to choose the correct injector for the Cummins 5.9L engine with a common rail fuel system used in the Dodge pickup and Ford F650 and F750 medium duty trucks.

Provide DIPACO / DTech Customer Experience with the vehicle VIN number and / or engine serial number and we will determine the correct injector for you. An incorrect injector may be identified if an engine from another model year or vehicle has been installed, or the engine has been repaired or modified.

Use of the incorrect injector will cause hard starting, white or black smoke, low fuel mileage, and low power.
