We have received your request to provide Conflict Minerals disclosure and/or certification.

Chief Enterprises, a distributor, is committed to sourcing responsibly and considers mining activities that fuel conflict as unacceptable. Chief Enterprises's efforts related to conflict minerals are aligned to the work of the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC) and Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI). The EICC's and GeSI's work includes the Conflict-Free Smelter Program and the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template ("Template"). Chief Enterprises has requested of all our suppliers to use the latest version of the CMRT template (version 6.1) as a common industry approach for the reporting and collection of sourcing information related to conflict minerals.

As a distributor, and not a manufacturer, Chief Enterprises continues to collect conflict minerals data from our suppliers. As we perform our due diligence to obtain the requested information, please be aware that we are at the mercy of our suppliers as to the extent of information that they provide.
