## HOW TO CHOOSE THE CORRECT BLASTERALL GLOVE SIZE

Hand injuries are one of the most common injuries on blasting jobsite. However, using Blasterall protective gloves gives your operators the hand protection they deserve. Blasterall Gloves offer resistance to abrasion, impacts, cuts, and more. It is important to wear the right size gloves to ensure the optimal levels of dexterity and comfort. Glove size measures in inches so all you need is a tape measure or ruler to identify the glove size for you. To determine your glove size, measure from the tip of your middle finger to the wrinkle at the base of your hand. Then wrap a fabric measuring tape around the widest part of your hand just below the knuckle (excluding your thumb). Once you have both these measurements, use the larger of the two to determine the proper glove size. Typically the first measurement works for $95 \%$ of people. If you don't have a fabric tape, this is the easiest way to find your glove size.

Below you will find sizes by number as well as letter sizes:

- If your hand measures 5.5-6 inches, choose size 6, X Small.
- If your hand measures 6.5-7 inches, choose size 7, Small.
- If your hand measures 7.5-8 inches, choose size 8, Medium.
- If your hand measures 8.5-9 inches, choose size 9, Large.
- If your hand measures 9.5 - 10 inches, choose size $10, \mathrm{XL}$.
- If your hand measures 10.5-11 inches, choose size 11, XXL.


## GLOVE SIZING CHART

Take the larger of the two measurements to determine proper glove size.
